## DAY 1

**Do Any Of These Day In A Day:**

- #1 Visit **Gold Beach Visitor Center** for complete information for your adventure, take a picture with Goldie B. Rogue even pick-up a Gold Beach Rocks Paint Kit! The Visitor Center is the only place in Gold Beach with handicap access while also offering free of charge mobility track chairs to take to the beach for those who are mobility challenged! *Just ask for David's chair!*
- **Jerry's Rogue Jets!** Celebrate almost 70 years of the Original Wild River-the Rogue, on the one-of-a-kind Jerry's Jet Boat Tours since 1958. Running May 1st to mid October, Jerry's is the only river trip authorized to take you into the Wild & Scenic Rogue Wilderness adventures!
- **Agate or sand dollar hunting** on the beach ! Not sure what agate is? Check out the examples at the Visitor Center
- **Crabbing or clamming**, you need to check regulations at ODFW site
- **Beachcombing**, find all kinds of keepsake treasures
- **Explore tidepools** at low tide
- **Visit Cape Sebastian** lookout point, best drive-to-view of the Pacific Ocean
- **Guided fishing trip** on the Rogue River or the Pacific
- **Search for glass floats** all month of April and many major Holidays, starting point is at the Visitor center, come on in for a treasure map
- **Visit the Curry County Historic Museum**
- **Explore the Port of Gold Beach** and see the Historical wreck of 1881 steamer boat Mary D. Hume and visit Jerry's Museum, located inside their gift shop
- **Hike!** 3 easy trails near the Rogue River! Start with Rogue River walk at Jim Hunt ! Then hit two more closer to Lobster Creek Bridge, Frances-Shrader Old Growth Trail or The Myrtlewood Trail. (largest Myrtlewood Tree in Oregon)
- **Visit the Curry County Veterans Memorial**
- **Historic Indian Fish Hatchery** - call for appointment and visit between Memorial and Labor day

## DAY 4

**Any of Day One, Two & Three:**

- **Shopping for gifts**, Several unique options ask the Visitor Center for a map of local establishments
- **Cedar Bend Golf course** an 18 hole course tucked away only 15 minutes away
- **Disk Golf** at Buffington park
- **Golf South** at Salmon Run, for the more advanced golfers
- **Golf North** at one of Bandon's seven golf courses, dunes or grass they aim to please

## DAY 2

**Any of Day One Plus:**

- **Head North to Cape Blanco Lighthouse** - furthest point west on the Oregon Coast, prepare yourself for the wind and awesome views of the coast line!
- **Ride** the state designated Wild Rivers Coast Scenic Bikeway & visit the Elk River Fish Hatchery on the way
- **Visit historic Hughes House** on the way to the lighthouse
- **Visit Port Orford's** dolly docks and historic Lifeboat station, impressive
- **Stop by Prehistoric Gardens** on the way back
- **Stormy weather?** We got this covered, best stormwatching is at Otter Point on Old Coast Road
- **Head south - Samuel Boardman State Scenic Corridor** it's a must see and if you keep going on 101 south, it will take you through the World-famous Redwoods! Popular place to visit is The Trees of Mystery !
- **Meyer's beach at Pistol River** is known for body boarding, wind and kite surfing
- **Feeling thirsty - Arch Rock Brewery**, their new tasting room is located at the Turtle Rock Resort

## DAY 3

**Any of Day One & Two Plus:**

- **Another beach day!** Visit Gold Beach Visitor Center and ask for a sand castle kit, borrow one for free
- **Fly a kite.** celebrate the wind!
- **Rent a Fat Tire Bike** or a paddle board, it's so fun
- **More hiking ! River or coastal.** check out all the mapped trails at our Visitor Center or plan a whole day for hiking at Humbug Mountain trail, best views are at the top
- **Visit the community of Agness** on the Scenic portion of the Wild Rogue River! Have lunch, picnic or even stay the night at any of the three upriver lodges, Cougar Lane even has a store !
- **South Coast Tours** offers Whitewater rafting, kayaking or stand-up paddle boarding tours
- **Secret Beach kayaking**
